MAINTENANCE TIPS

At Marine Corps Base Hawaii, we take great pride in maintaining our 2,576 homes and common areas to ensure they are well-kept for future generations of military families. When you accept your home offer, you are agreeing to accept the property in its current condition, with the fixtures provided.

If you wish to make any physical modifications to your home, landscaping, or exterior, you must first obtain written approval from your RSO. All requests will be reviewed in accordance with the Universal Lease Agreement, the Marine Community Handbook, and base orders issued by Command.

If modifications are made without prior approval, your RSO will work with you to address the situation. You may be asked to submit a request for approval or to restore the property to its original condition. The decision to approve modifications is at the discretion of OMC, and this includes changes to the exterior appearance and landscaping of your home.

For guidance on maintaining your home and yard, always refer to the Marine Community Handbook and your lease contract. If you have any questions or need assistance, please don't hesitate to contact your RSO. We're here to help!
