OMC Marine Maintenance Department: 2024 Performance Highlights

We're excited to share a summary of the OMC Marine Maintenance Department's performance in 2024, highlighting our ongoing commitment to providing dedicated and reliable support to our community. Below are the highlights of the service's work order completion metrics, ensuring that you are informed about the ongoing efforts to maintain and improve our facilities.

- Emergency Work Orders: 3,794 completed with an on-time response rate of 95.49%.
- Urgent Work Orders: 1,950 completed, with a strong on-time response rate of 98.06%.
- Routine Work Orders: 25,306 completed, with an on-time response rate of 95.87%.
- Internal Work Orders: 3,242 completed.

Overall, 34,292 work orders were completed in 2024, with a 96.47% on-time response rate.

MAINTENANCE

Enhancing energy efficiency in your Ohana Marine home during February 2025 not only contributes to environmental sustainability but also aligns with the Marine Corps' energy conservation goals. Here are practical steps to reduce energy consumption:

1. Thermostat Management:

- **Optimal Settings:** Maintain indoor temperatures at 74°F in Hawaii for best practice. Each degree below this can increase energy consumption by approximately 3%.
- **Nighttime Adjustments:** Raise the thermostat by 7-10°F while sleeping or when away from home to potentially save up to 10% on energy costs.

2. Appliance and Lighting Usage:

- **Unplug Idle Devices:** Disconnect appliances and electronics when not in use to prevent "phantom" energy consumption, which can add up over time.
- **LED Lighting:** Replace your high-efficiency LED lights for free at self-help to reduce electricity by ensuring correct wattage is being used for your fixtures.
