To submit a work order, you can call (808) 470-5400, option 3, use the Hunt Resident App, submit through the online portal, or visit the Resident Services Office in person. For lightbulbs above 9 feet, or issues with screws, debris, or bugs, please submit a work order for assistance.

Lightbulb Replacement:

If you have lightbulbs higher than 9 feet, please submit a work order, and we'll handle the replacement.

Roof Leaks: Emergency Response

If you experience a roof leak, report it immediately. We'll secure the leak and return to repair once hazardous weather clears.

Bug-Free Home Tips:

- Seal Cracks & Gaps: Check windows and doors for gaps.
- Store Food Properly: Use airtight containers and clean spills promptly.
- Take Out Trash Regularly.
- Clean Kitchen Surfaces: Wipe down counters and eliminate standing water.
